Contestants: Please take home this application and discuss it with your parents.

Pageant is open to any single high school girl (9th-12th grade), who was born a female, from any area high school, and 10th or 11th grade girls from Sikeston High School (Jr. Miss Sikeston winner is not eligible to participate the year after she won), who has never been married or pregnant.

Pageant Date & Time: Saturday, October 2, 2021 @ 1:30 pm. **All contestants need to be at the building behind the stage by 1:00 dressed and ready to go on stage.**

Pageant Location: Sikeston Jaycee Bootheel Rodeo Grounds

Photograph: All girls participating must have a recent photograph (head and shoulders only) to turn in with the entry form. The contestant will be fully responsible for getting the photograph turned in with the entry form by Friday, September 24, 2021. **NO LATE ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOS WILL BE ACCEPTED! NO EXCEPTIONS!** All photos will be returned the day of the pageant.

Entry Fee: Each contestant will be required to pay a \$30.00 entry fee, which must accompany her picture, Covid-19 release form and entry form. Please make check payable to Miss Cotton Carnival Pageant.

If you feel that your application will not reach us by the deadline, call and you will be given a place to drop it off. If you decide to drop application off, they must be dropped off by 5:00 pm on deadline date.

On Saturday morning (Oct. 1) before the pageant begins, all Miss Cotton Carnival contestants are **REQUIRED** to ride in the Cotton Carnival Parade which begins at 10:00 a.m. at the Sikeston Senior High School. There will be a member of the pageant committee at the parade to make sure you participate. Your car should have signs on each side stating your name, "Miss Cotton Carnival Contestant", the school that you attend, and sponsor (if applicable). All queen contestants need to be lined up **by 9:30 a.m.** on Matthews Street facing east (facing Sikeston High School). If your school band participates in the parade, you can request to be placed in the parade line up by your band. If you are in your school band and required to march, riding in the parade as a Miss Cotton Carnival contestant is optional, but please let us know in advance.

After the contest, please take all personal belongings with you. We will not be responsible for anything left behind. Please pick up the photograph that was mailed in with your entry form before you leave the pageant.

Important Update for the 2021 Cotton Carnival Pageants

Due to Covid 19, the pageants will be run a little differently this year. We will, to the best of our ability, try to limit close contact. Please be aware, this is a pageant and multiple contestants will be on stage at the same time. With that being said, we are implementing the following for the contestants and their parents/guardian:

-ONLY 1 person will be allowed in the dressing room with the contestant. This will be STRICTLY enforced. NO EXCEPTIONS. The guest will have to **wear a mask** at all times while backstage and they will be asked to leave the dressing room, 30 minutes prior to the pageant start time and will not be allowed back stage again until the pageant ends.

-The contestant needs to come FULLY dressed to the pageant. This includes having make-up on and hair fixed. We do not have room for everyone to dress, apply make-up, finish hair and still keep contestants at a social distance. The only exception will be, if the contestant's dress is long and will drag on the ground, you may bring it and put it on in the dressing room.

-If you feel bad, are sick in any way, have been sick a few days before the pageant, have a cough or are running a fever, PLEASE do not come to the pageant. We will be taking temperatures before you will be allowed to enter the pageant area and anyone with a temp above 99.5 will not be admitted backstage at all.

-The Sikeston Henry F Meldrum Post No. 114 of the American Legion will in no way be held responsible for anyone coming in contact with or contracting the Covid 19 virus while at the Cotton Carnival. **By signing below, you are entering your child and/or will be viewing this pageant, knowing the risks and accept all responsibility for yourself and your child. Failure to sign this form will result in your child not being allowed to participate in the pageant. This form must be returned with the pageant application. Until we receive this form your child will not be entered in the pageant. Also, once entered, there will NO REFUNDS unless the pageant is cancelled.**

Queens are required to do community service with the American Legion Post 114 and the local veterans during the year holding their title. This is a way the queens can give back to the American Legion for sponsoring the pageants.

There are monthly meetings to attend, along with helping out at other events, such as serving Thanksgiving dinner, Christmas shopping for the veterans in nursing homes, helping with family fun day, being present when awards are being presented and helping with the Memorial Day and Labor Day events sponsored by the American Legion. These are just to name a few of the events in which the Queens are asked to participate. The queen's families are welcome to participate also. All community hours can be recorded for the community hours required by Sikeston High School to receive the gold chord for graduation. During the events, the queens are asked to wear their crown and sash and be dressed appropriately. The Standard Democrat is usually on hand to take picture for the newspaper.

Also, Miss Sikeston and Miss Cotton Carnival (if she is a senior) can join the American Legion. If the queen chooses to join, they will then be able to apply for a scholarship from the American Legion Post 114.
