Pageant is open to any single high school girl (9th-12th grade), who was born a female, from any area high school, and 10th or 11th grade girls from Sikeston High School (Jr. Miss Sikeston winner is not eligible to participate the year after she won), who has never been married or pregnant.

Pageant Date & Time: Saturday, October 1, 2022 @ 1:30 pm. All contestants need to be at the building behind the stage by 1:00 dressed and ready to go on stage.

All photos will be returned the day of the pageant.

On Saturday morning (Oct. 1) before the pageant begins, all Miss Cotton Carnival contestants are **<u>REQUIRED</u></u>** to ride in the Cotton Carnival Parade which begins at 10:00 a.m.at the Sikeston Senior High School. There will be a member of the pageant committee at the parade to make sure you participate. Your car should have signs on each side stating your name, "Miss Cotton Carnival Contestant", the school that you attend, and sponsor (if applicable). All queen contestants need to be lined up <u>by 9:30 a.m.</u> on Matthews Street facing east (facing Sikeston High School). If your school band participates in the parade, you can request to be placed in the parade line up by your band. If you are in your school band and required to march, riding in the parade as a Miss Cotton Carnival contestant is optional, but please let us know in advance.

BEGINNING IN 2015, THE FOLLOWING WAS IMPLEMENTED AS A REQUIREMENT FOR THE NEW MISS SIKESTON, JR. MISS SIKESTON AND MISS COTTON CARNIVAL

Queens are required to do community service with the American Legion Post 114 and the local veterans during the year holding their title. This is a way the queens can give back to the American Legion for sponsoring the pageants.

There are monthly meetings to attend, along with helping out at other events, such as serving Thanksgiving dinner, Christmas shopping for the veterans in nursing homes, helping with family fun day, being present when awards are being presented and helping with the Memorial Day and Labor Day events sponsored by the American Legion. These are just to name a few of the events in which the Queens are asked to participate. The queen's families are welcome to participate also. All community hours can be recorded for the community hours required by Sikeston High School to receive the gold chord for graduation. During the events, the queens are asked to wear their crown and sash and be dressed appropriately. The Standard Democrat is usually on hand to take picture for the newspaper.

Also, Miss Sikeston and Miss Cotton Carnival (if she is a senior) can join the American Legion. If the queen chooses to join, they will then be able to apply for a scholarship from the American Legion Post 114.
